Local Knowledge – hints & tips for drivers

- There is free parking opposite the hospital for short waiting periods (or when you can't find a parking space in the car parks!), this will also negate parking costs. These are private business spaces, so please be wary of any parking restriction signs.
- We would not recommend parking and leaving your car unattended here, as it is not official 'free' or hospital parking!
- Nearby, free parking (for waiting or if you want to get a coffee etc) can often be found at the Dunelm, Wickes or McDonalds car park along Northfield Avenue (see maps on next pages)
- 24-hour parking onsite will incur costs which will be passed on to the passenger – see the following pages for further details

General Driving Directions:

- Leave A14 at Junction 7
- Head towards Kettering Town Centre (right hand lane leaving A14)
- Pass crematorium on left.
- To Entrance 1 – At Telford Way/Rothwell Road roundabout take right hand turn into hospital, past Ambulance Station to car parks.
- To Entrance 4 - Go straight over the roundabout on to Rothwell Road and take the fifth turning on your right just before the railway bridge.

KGH Car Parks

ANPR: KGH has an Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) system. When you join VA, or change your car, we send your car registration to KGH and they record it on their system, so you don't have to pay. When you exit a KGH car park, the barrier will lift automatically.

Should you have any difficulties, please speak to the car parking attendants in the “shed” at the exit from Car Park A.

Volunteer Spaces behind Warren Hill House:

There are three volunteer spaces behind Warren Hill House. You must display your VA car badge.

Drop Off/Pick-up: a drop off/pickup point can be found in Car Park A. You can go into the car park and exit the car park within 15 minutes the barrier will raise, and you will not be charged. If you are in the car park longer than 15 minutes, you will be charged the appropriate fee.

In an emergency or in exceptional circumstances, such as where a patient has very limited mobility, drivers may drop-off directly outside the Outpatients Department using the emergency vehicle access route then go and park.

You may need to allow extra time for your journey as queuing for the car parks can occur at peak times. If you have questions related to car parking, please visit the Car Parking office in Car Park A.

Car Park A

Car Park A is disabled car parking spaces only. Once parked, please take your valid Blue Badge to the Car Park Office and advise them of your registration number. You will then receive free parking for the duration of the stay.

Car Park B

Has a height Restriction of 2.1m.
It has 4 x Blue Badge spaces & 221 x spaces on the lower deck.

The upper deck is for staff with parking permits only.

Here's how it works:

When arriving at Car Park B your car registration number is captured automatically. Before leaving the car park you need to enter your registration number at the paying station before paying.

As you approach the entrance of the car park, the barrier will raise automatically, and your registration number will be read. Park your vehicle as usual.

When you are ready to leave, please pay at one of the pay stations by entering your registration number and following the on-screen instructions.

You can pay by cash or card (including contactless). Please return to your car immediately and proceed to the exit. The exit barrier will automatically raise once your registration number and payment has been verified.

Other car parks are available:

- Outside the Treatment Centre - Pay & Display parking
- Adjacent to Rothwell Road - Pay & Display parking
- You can pay by cash or card
- There is a 30 minute drop off area in front on Rockingham Wing

Concessions

Complex Treatments: if attending Lilford Ward, Centenary Wing or Chemotherapy Supportive Treatment Unit (CSSTU) for complex treatment, please discuss with the ward clerk. Collect a concessionary slip and take it to the Car Park Office in Car Park A to claim a concessionary charge.

Frequent Treatments: if attending Outpatients or Day Case for frequent treatments in a 7-day period, a weekly concessionary ticket can be purchased at Car Park A. It will cost £12 upon production of a ward or departmental confirmation.

Long Inpatient Stays: if a patient is expected to have a stay of 7 or more days, a weekly concessionary ticket can be purchased at Car Park A. It will cost £12 upon production of a ward or departmental confirmation.

Patient Buggy Service & Volunteer Drivers from hospital car parks to entrances are located around the site.

KGH has an outdoor buggy service to support less able patients to access all hospital car parks and entrances located around the site. The service is free to use and is supported by a team of trained buggy drivers from their Volunteer Service.

The service operates Monday to Friday 8.30am to 4.30pm excluding bank holidays (subject to volunteer availability).

When calling please state the pickup location, your destination and number of passengers (max 2).

The service is unable to:

- transport wheelchairs
- take passengers who are unable to step on to the buggy unaided
- transport children under the age of 12

There is a Meet and Greet facility at Hospital and Kettering General Hospital.

Anyone can book this (including VA when we are taking a booking on behalf of the passenger).

This allows a hospital volunteer to be present with a wheelchair to assist the passenger within the hospital.

From Monday 17th March, Car Park D outside the Treatment Centre will be temporarily closed...

While Car Park D is closed:-

- The assisted parking bays on the road up to the Treatment Centre, Zone G, will be inaccessible
- Patients will still be able to be dropped off/collected outside the Treatment Centre and at the entrance/exit of Zone C by Pathology Traffic marshals will be on duty during the day to assist drivers
- Visitor parking spaces will not be reduced; however, some will be relocated to Car Park F
- Staff parking will be redirected to other locations on-site

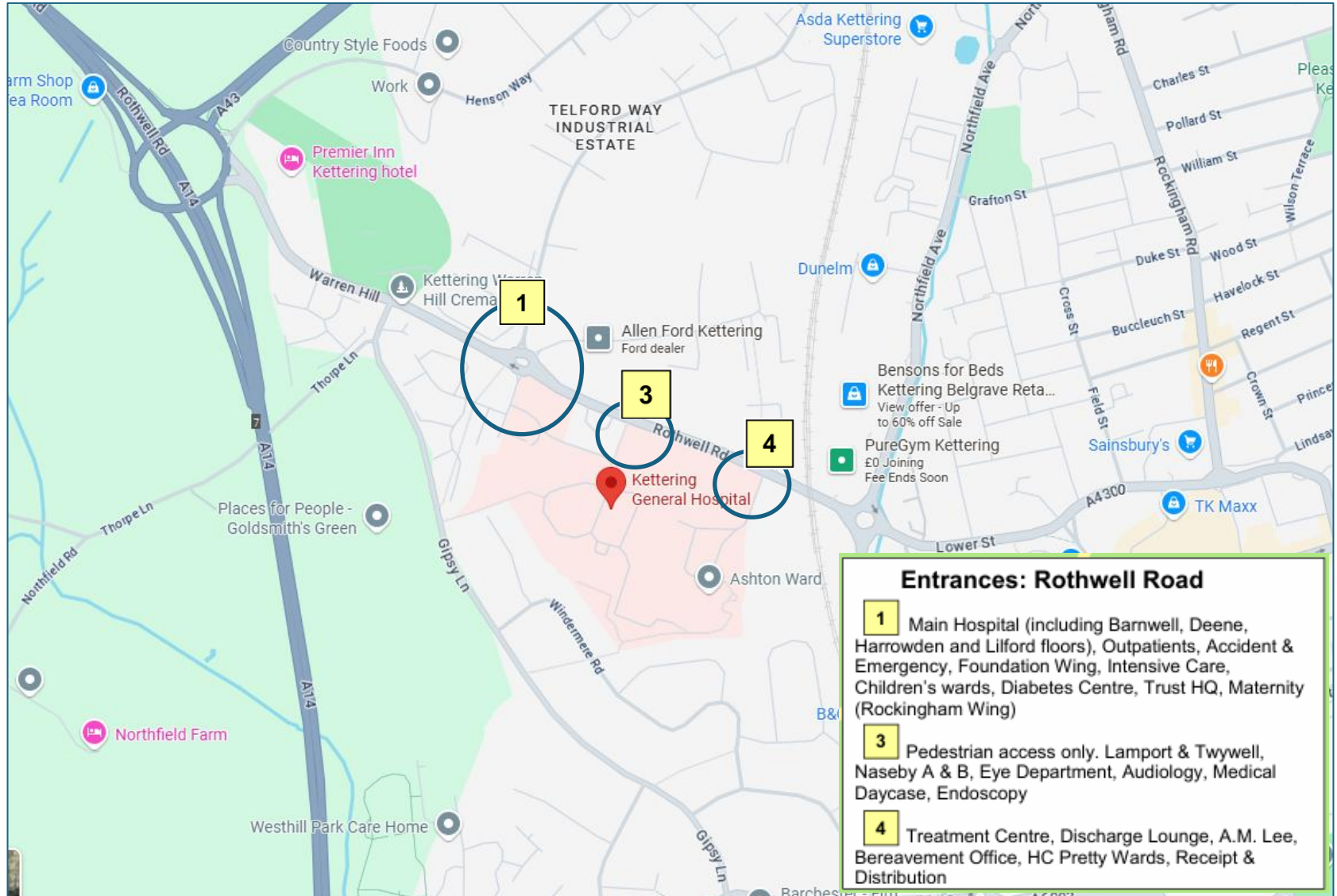
During this time, traffic diversions will be in place and a system of two-way traffic will be in operation, where previously this was one way traffic. The road up to Pathology and behind the stores will be managed by traffic wardens during normal working hours to assist drivers and help ease the flow of traffic for visitors, staff and delivery vehicles. We understand this may cause some inconvenience, and we greatly appreciate your patience and understanding as we continue with our efforts to improve Kettering General Hospital's infrastructure. 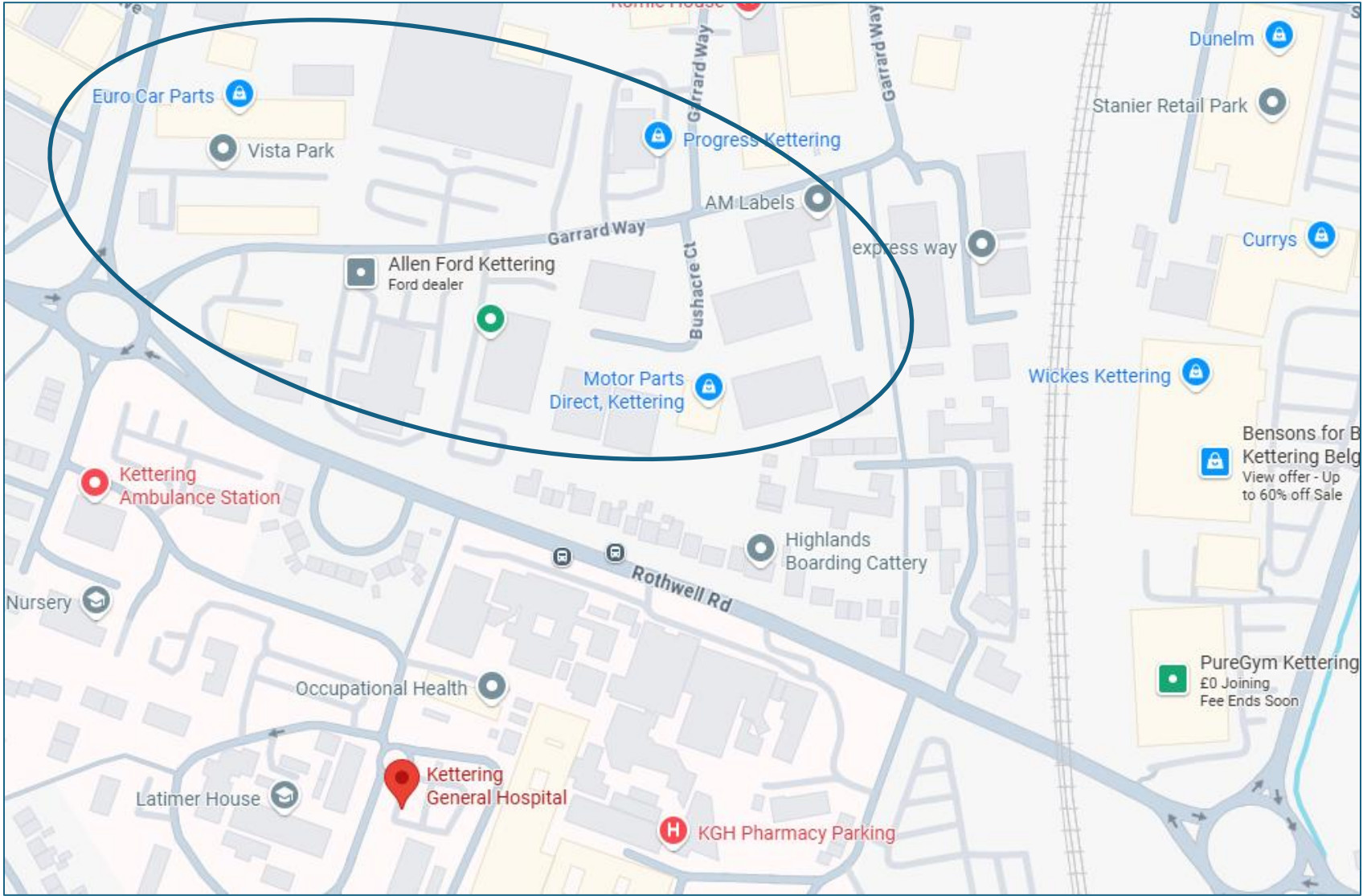

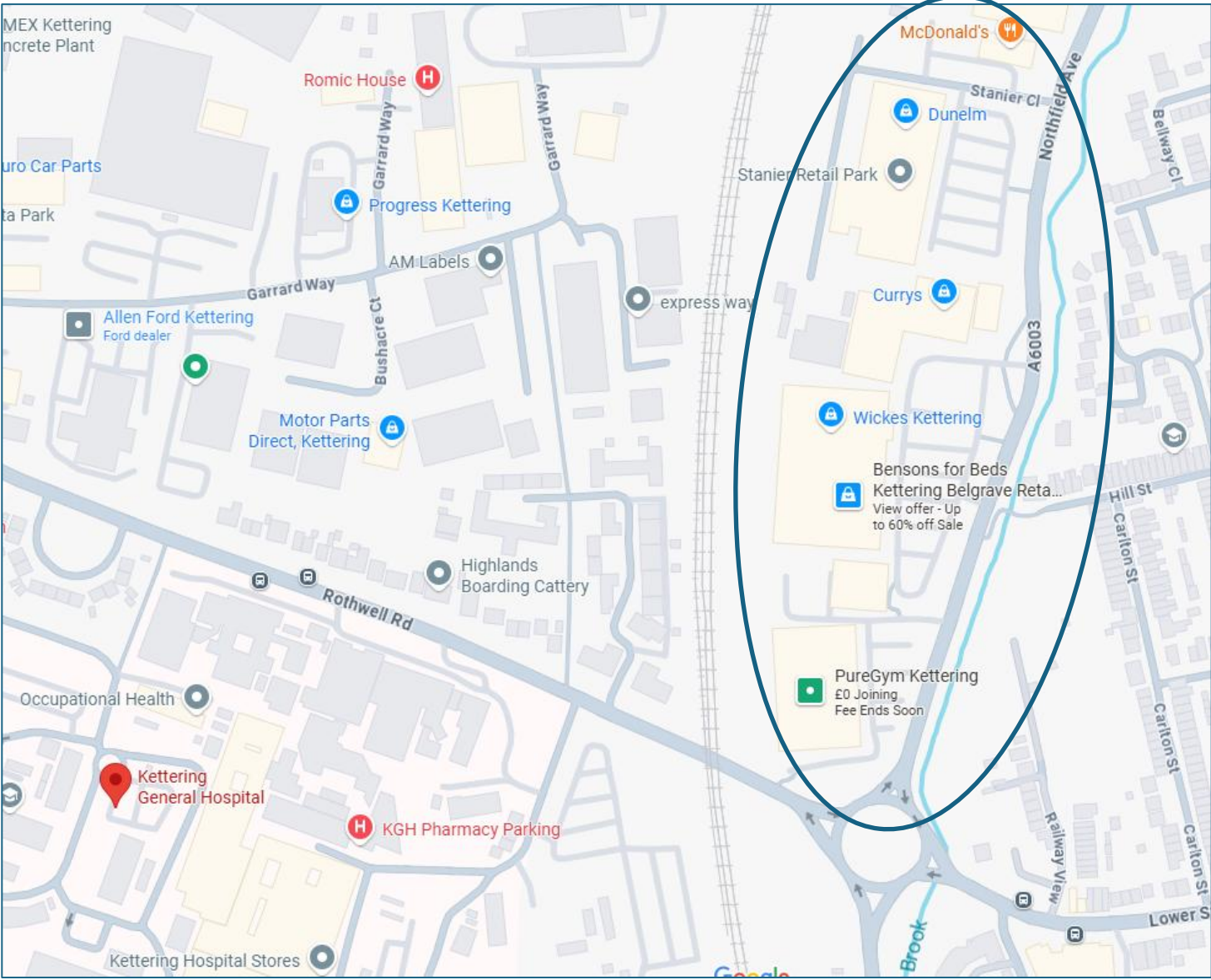
Work on the new [Energy Centre](#) is set to begin in early September 2024. These works will be located at the bottom of the hospital site and requires Car Park D to be closed while it is dug up to accommodate essential utility pipe relocation. Anticipated works will last for eight weeks. As a result, we will be closing and moving some visitor and staff parking spaces to alternative [car parks](#).

While these necessary changes and construction works may lead to increased traffic within the hospital grounds, we are working hard to minimise disruption and ensure that patient and visitor parking remains unaffected.

We appreciate your patience and sincerely apologise for any inconvenience these essential works may cause. Thank you for your understanding.





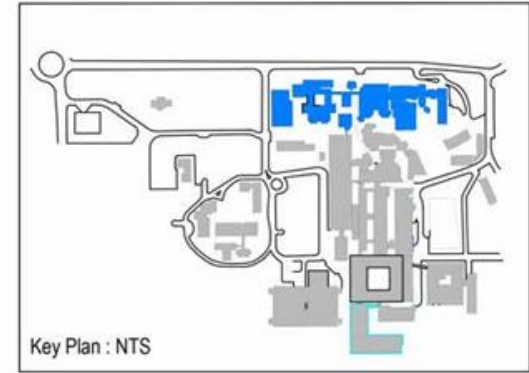
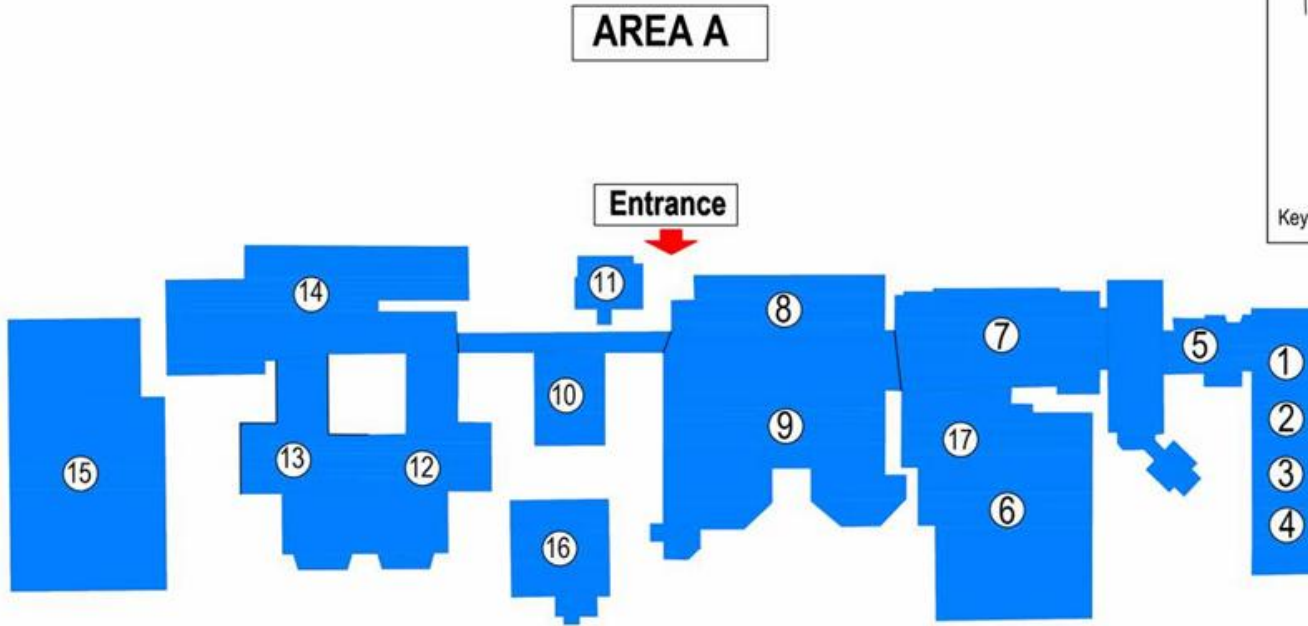
