General Directions

- From Oundle, follow the A605 west/south
- Join the A45 at the A14 junction at Thrapston Interchange
- Follow the A45 past Higham Ferrers and through Little Ilchester for 21 miles
- Take the 3rd exit onto A428 / Bedford Road
- Take the 4th turning on the right at the traffic lights into the hospital grounds (south entrance)
- Visitor car parks can be found along this road
- There are a number of disabled / blue badge parking opposite the hospital entrance within Car Park 1 and further along the road on the left

There is a Meet and Greet facility at Northampton General Hospital (and Kettering General Hospital).

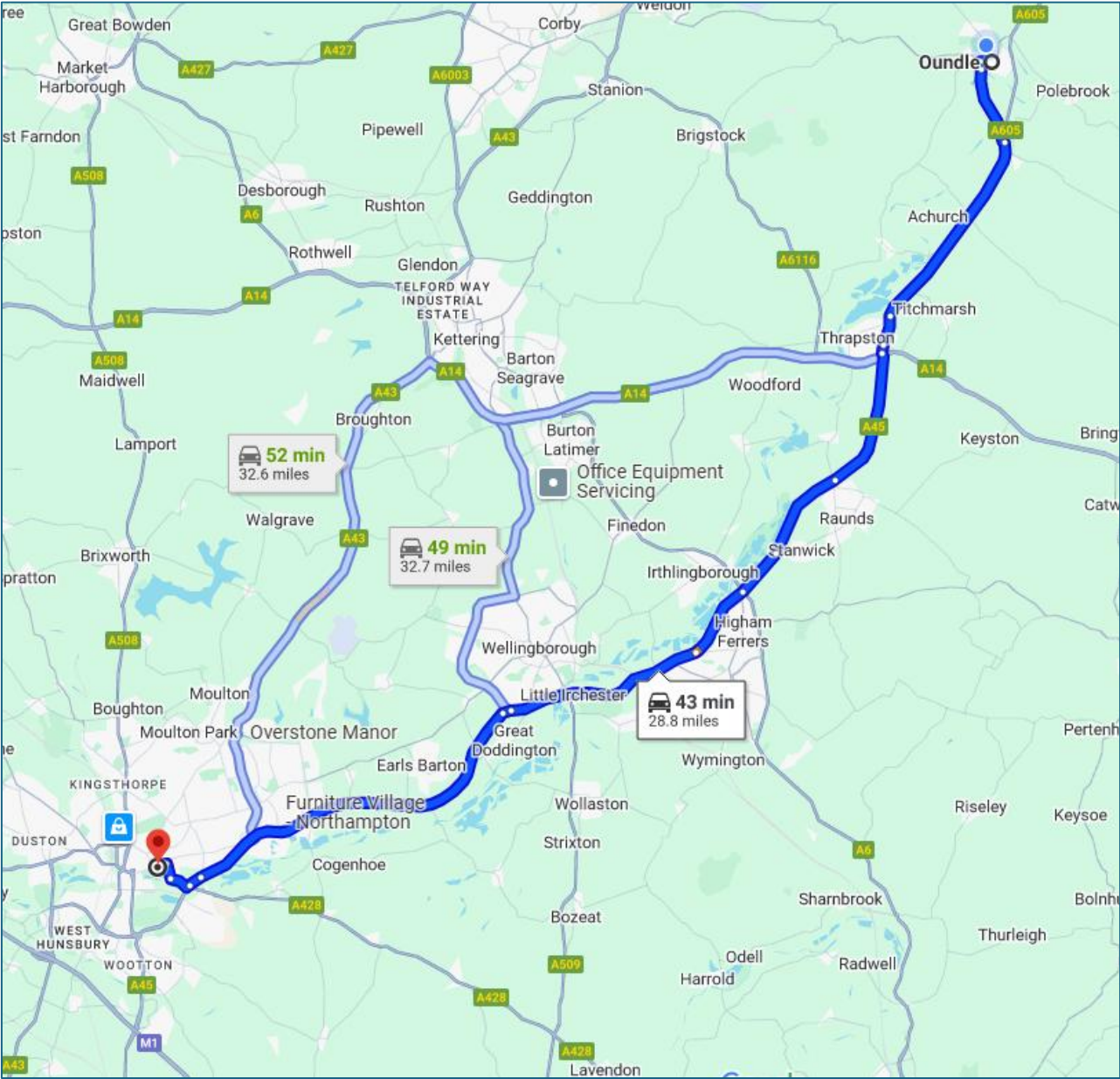
Anyone can book this (including VA when we are taking a booking on behalf of the passenger).

Car Parking

We now use Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) in all of our car parks across Northampton General Hospital.

The car parks on site are managed by our in-house estates team and we do charge for parking to support with the upkeep and maintenance of the car parks. This is not a commercial operation and any additional money raised is invested back into our patient and visitor services.

The ANPR system photographs all vehicles that enter and leave the hospital site. These cameras are linked to on-site pay machines meaning you can now pay when you leave to the hospital.

Some of the main benefits of ANPR include:

- pay on exit meaning you only pay for the hours you need
- card and cash payments or pay by Trust Parking App

- better vehicle movement across our sites
- quicker entrance and exit to our car parks
- free drop off and pick up for 30 minutes including taxi's

To pay for parking, visitors to the hospital will need to make a note of their registration number to input into the ANPR pay machines. To pay, please visit one of the pay machines before you exit the car park.

There's no need to pay in advance, and no need to display a ticket.

You will need to input your full car registration number in order to pay.

You can pay using cash, card, contactless or by app at the payment machines.

Patients and visitors will still need to park in marked bays and adhere to car parking rules.

ANPR will not impact concessions for Blue Badge users and some other patient and visitor groups and the price of parking for other users remains the same.

Blue Badge

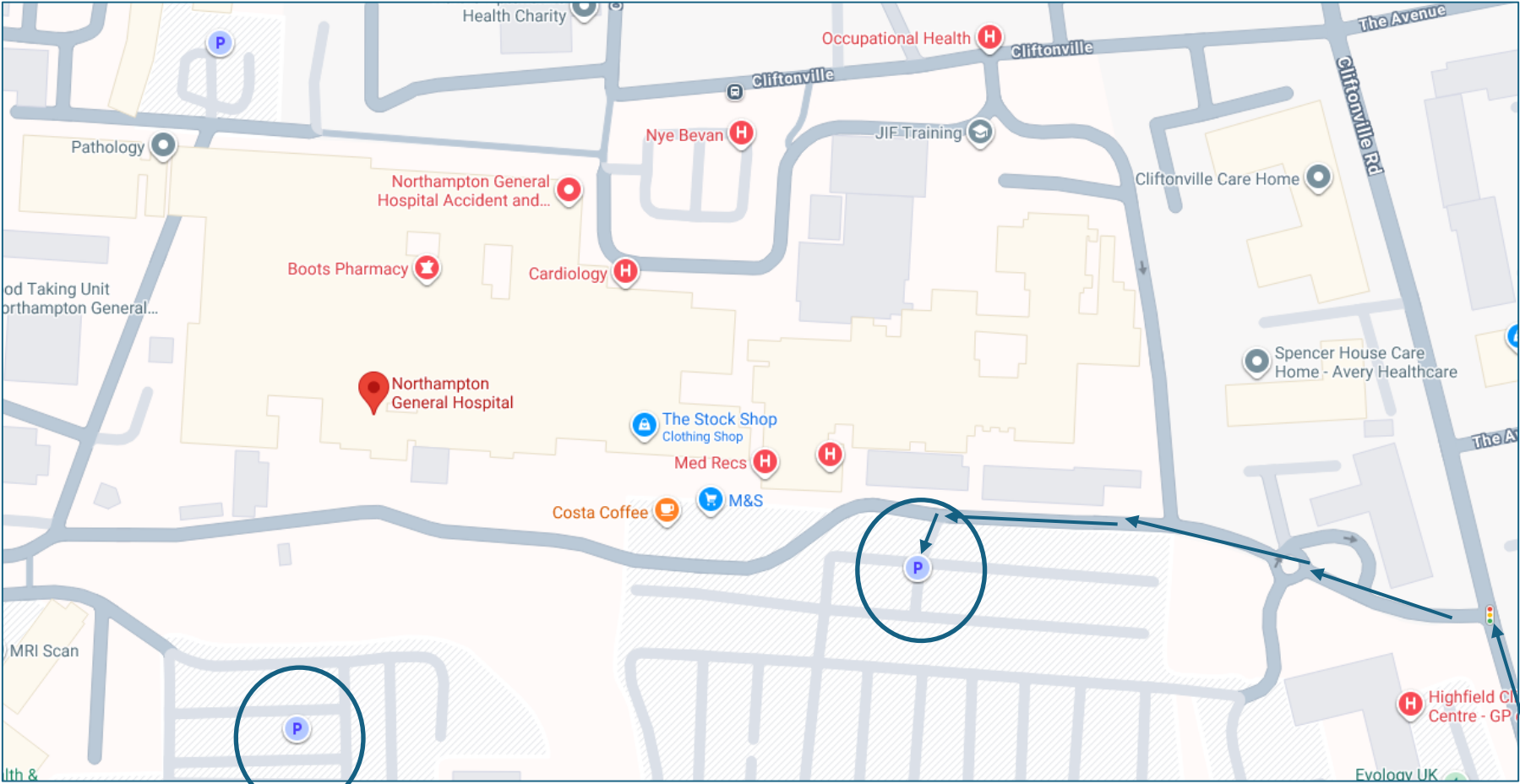
Parking is free for registered disabled Blue Badge holders in our public car parks and in marked disabled bays.

You must **register your blue badge every day you visit the hospital** to ensure your details are relevant and up to date.

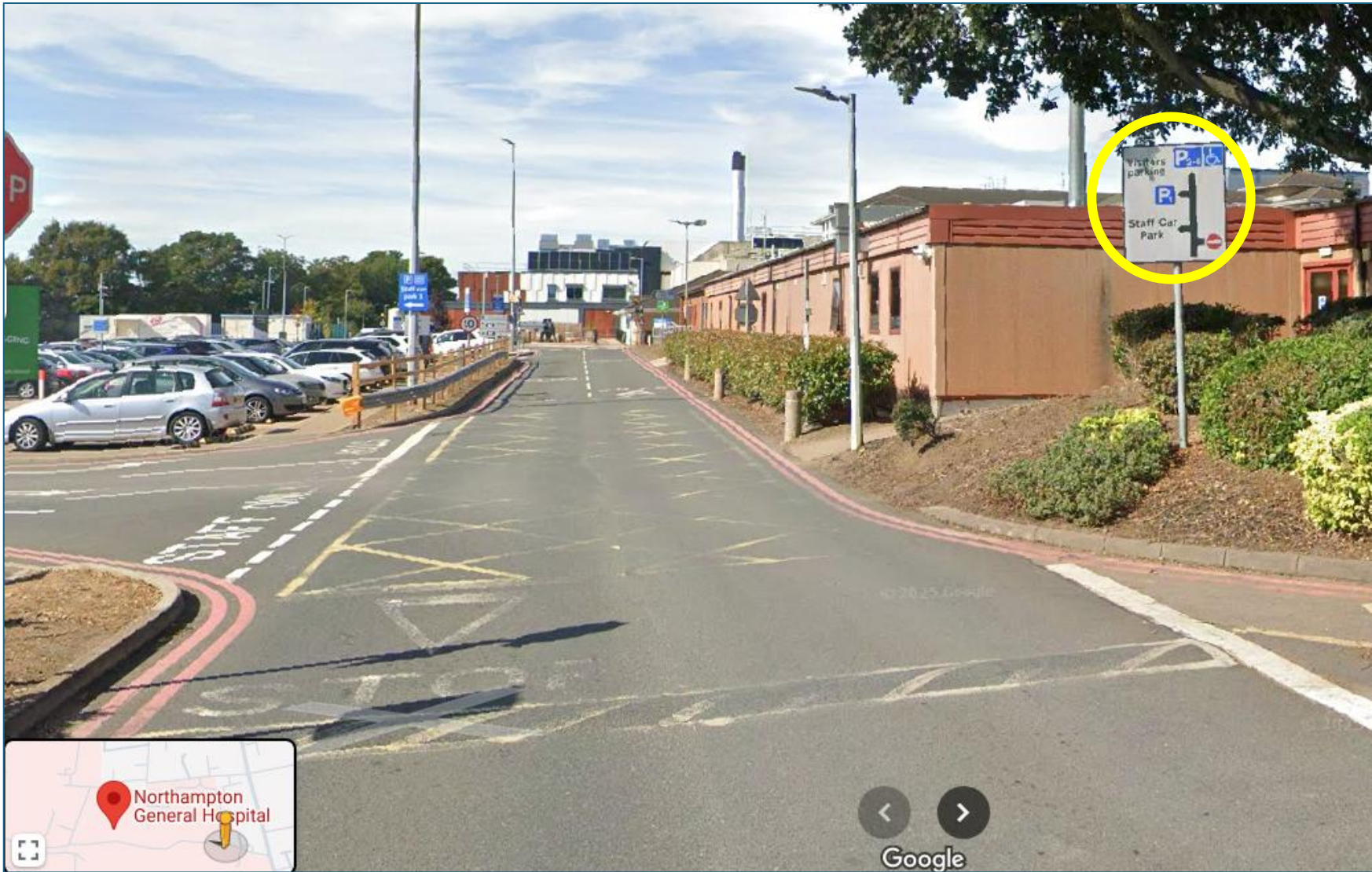
