Local Knowledge – hints & tips for drivers

- The hospital is situated off Junction 16 of the A47 on Bretton Gate. It is easily accessed from routes in the city and is just two miles from the city centre.



General Driving Directions:

- Head east along the A605 from Oundle
- Pass over the A1 at Peterborough Services onto Fletton Parkway
- At the third roundabout, take the first exit onto Nene Parkway
- At the third roundabout, turn right (3rd exit) onto the A47
- Leave the A47 at junction 16, taking the third exit onto Bretton Gate
- At the next/first set of traffic lights, turn right onto Cavell Close
- The second right takes you into **Car Park A** (women and children's unit) and The Cavell Centre
- The third right off Cavell Close takes you to **Car Park C**
- Continue further along Cavell Close for:
 - **Car Parks B** (staff only)
 - **Car Park E**
 - **F** (haematology/ oncology)
 - **G & H** on the left, with **Car Park D** being all the way round on the far right
- If you or your passenger has a Disable Blue Badge, there are **disabled parking bays** directly in front of the main entrance (and where the volunteer bays **used** to be), as well as in **Car Parks D, G & H**

Car Parking & Costs

All car parks are 'pay on leaving'. Please take a ticket when entering the car park and pay at the pay machines in either the main atrium, the Emergency Department foyer or outside the Women's and Children's Unit entrance.

Please note that all the usual methods of payment are accepted throughout the Trust to include cash, debit/credit card and contactless payment.

A concessionary rate of £2.60 per day applies for:

- Patients whose appointment time exceeds four hours due to a long wait in clinic
- Parents of a child or young person under 18 (between the hours of 8am and 7pm) or a birthing partner (anytime)
- The main visitor or carer to a critically ill or terminally ill patient on a daily basis (one vehicle only)
- A relative visiting a patient on a daily basis for a prolonged period of time (exceeding 7 days)
- The main carer of a patient in the hospital

Volunteer Parking

IF you must go into a car park (although hopefully you won't need to), disabled passengers can get their ticket validated at the Main Reception, Women and Children's Unit or Haematology & Oncology Unit (on provision of their disabled badges) to get out of the car park free of charge.

However, after getting the ticket validated, you will still need to go to the ticket machine – but it should not charge you!

Your VA Badge will also facilitate ticket validation at the above locations, just remember to also get the ticket machine to validate it before exiting.

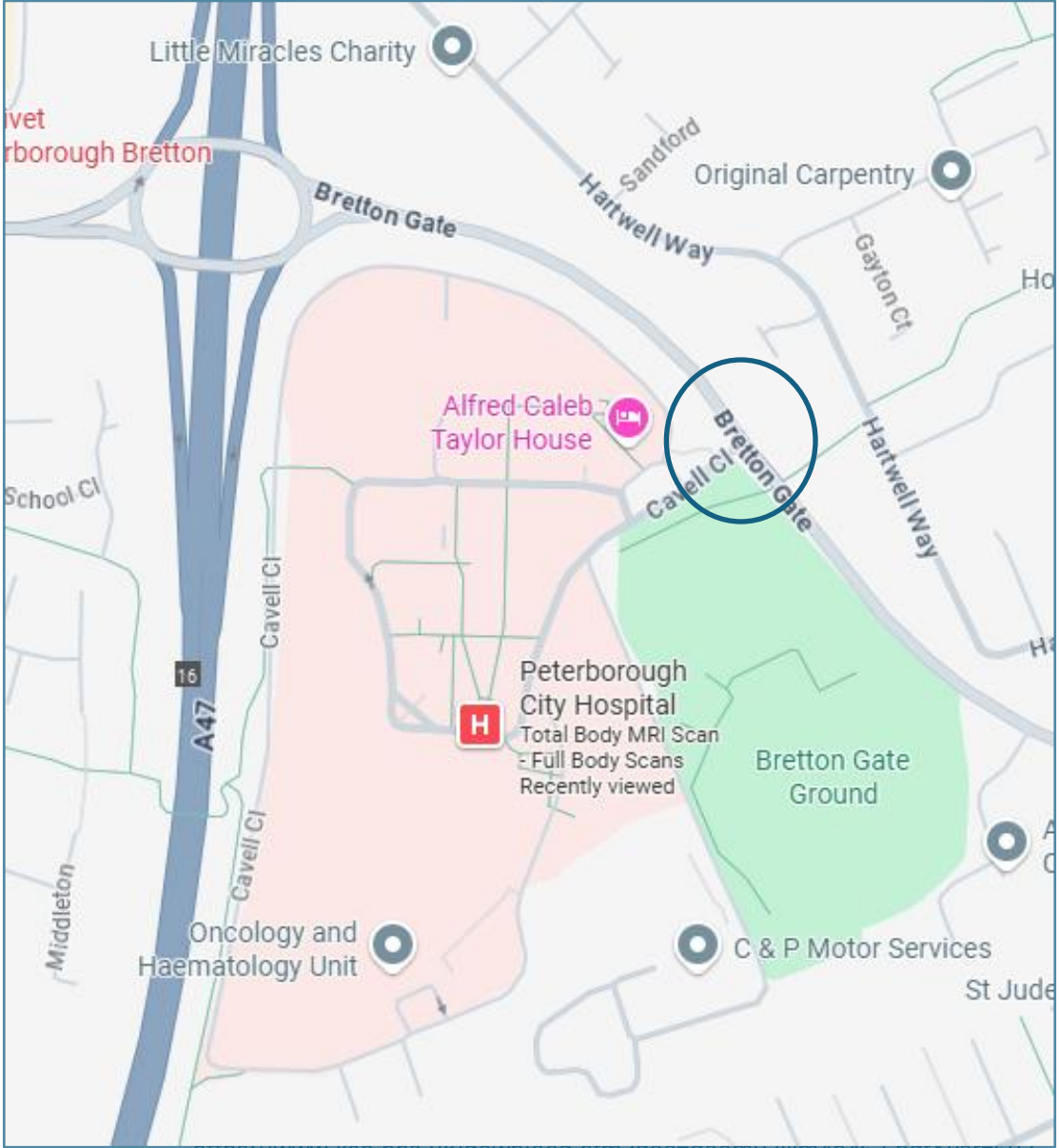
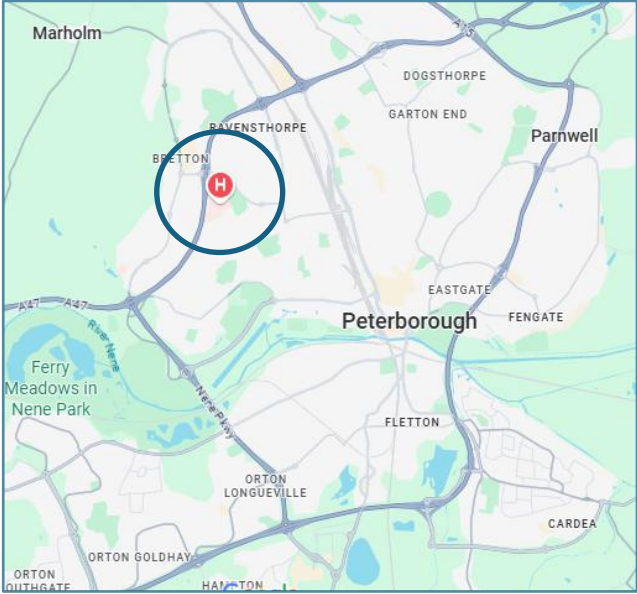
Drop off Zone

Approx 20 metres past the main entrance is a drop off zone.

There is no parking charge for:

- A patient with a long-term illness or serious condition needing regular treatment, such as chemotherapy, blood transfusions, acupuncture and some other specialised treatments
- Visitors to the Bereavement Centre or Chaplaincy Services
- Parents of a child in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit or Special Care Baby Unit
- Blue Badge holders
- Parents of a child or young person under 18 overnight (between the hours of 7.30pm and 8am)
